### 18 - What aspects of the course and/or Harley Roe's instructional methods have you found the most useful or valuable for learning? Please give examples. -

• Professor Roe's practice of direct engagement with academic literature combined with well-structured lectures and applicable explanations were incredibly valuable for this course. With a subject as broad as "institutional design," it can be difficult to find the best ways to explain certain concepts. Professor Roe demonstrated extraordinarily strong command of the subject matter, developing a series of lectures which were not only engaging but informative, and approached institutional design from multiple angles. Structuring the course around the reading of academic articles also gave students the chance to place their substantive knowledge into practice and challenged them to take innovative approaches to research. With a variation in familiarity with academic literature among the students in the course. Professor Roe managed to effectively instruct each student by taking time to provide multiple examples and walking students through the more challenging aspects of article analysis and research design. His approach to helping students understand statistical significance and value interpretation in terms of comparative political theory was probably the most valuable aspect of the course. As someone who has taken several political science methods courses previously, his explanations were more clear and comprehensible than some of the prior ones I had received. Most importantly, though, is the fact that Professor Roe cares deeply for this subject and for student learning. Active participation and a willingness to share information about his own research allowed students the chance to see the concepts in practice in real time. Altogether, Professor Roe's clear structure, innovative course design, and passion for his subject made this course an undoubtedly valuable experience.

- The only aspect of the course that I believe could be improved would be the time allotted to each unit. I understand that as a summer course, the timing of lessons was significantly more restricted, but I believe it would be better served as a Summer C course rather than Summer A to give students adequate time to process the information given and dig deeper into the papers discussed. The material itself is well structured and highly relevant to the goals of the class.
- Honestly not much, I felt like each class had a clear goal and was well connected to the papers we were reading.
- I feel the material we learn in the class should be more interactive. For me, we took too many articles for the course and should have concentrated more on more "independent" materials (not only reading the papers and then analyzing them). I also would recommend to give more
